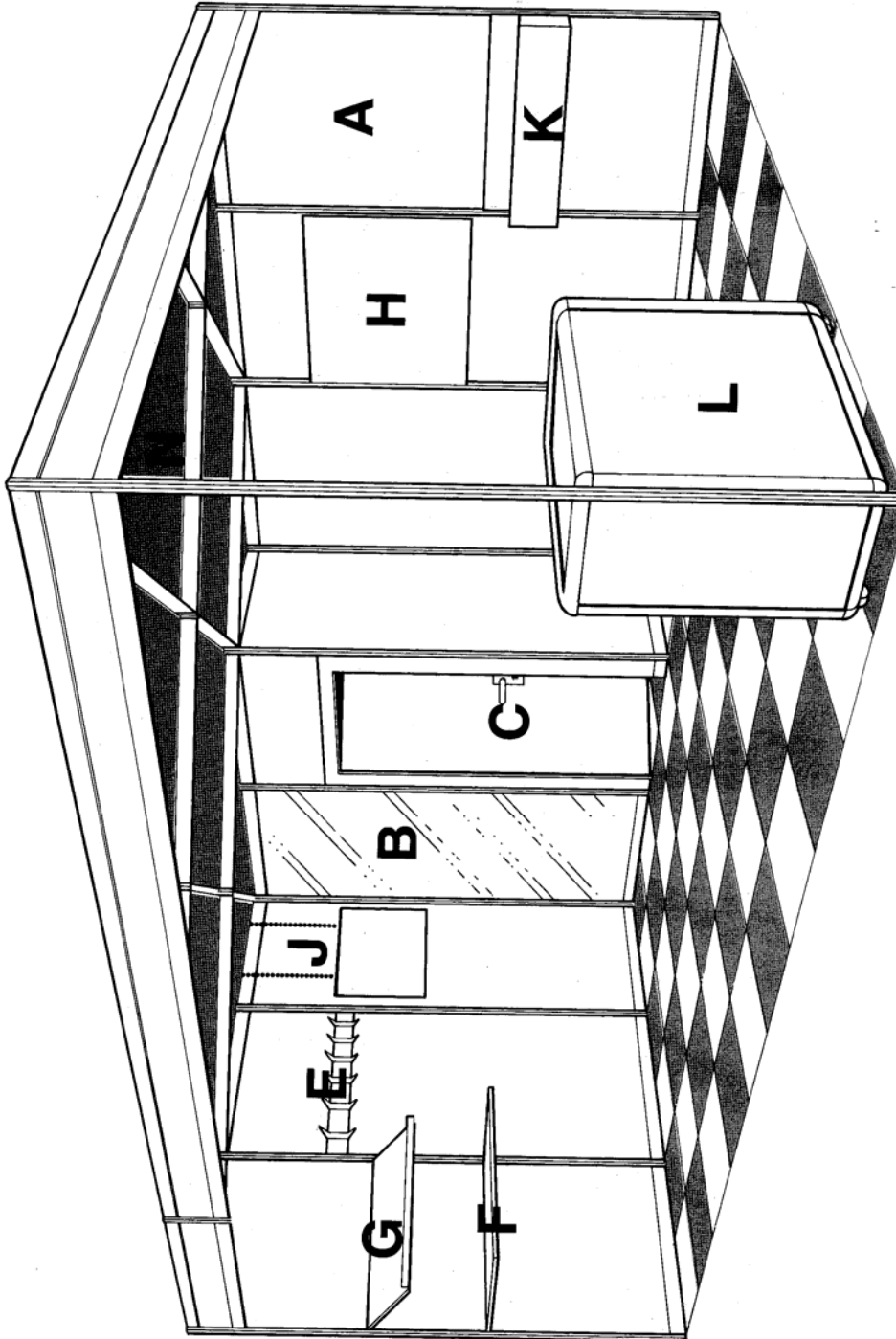

CODE	STANDARD ITEMS	
A	WALL PANELS	Wall panels are available to form additional partitioning and enclosures and match the shell scheme. Panel size 2.5m high x 1m wide (nominal).
B	WINDOW PANELS	Wall panels as above made up of solid infill from floor to 1m high and clear glass infill from 1m to 2.5m high or glazed full height. Venetian blinds behind windows are available.
C	LOCKABLE DOOR	Lockable doors complete with keys available for access to enclosed areas. When ordering, please indicate clearly exact position of door and the direction of opening. Keys to be returned at the close of the show.
D	CURTAINED ENTRANCE	2m high x 0.95m wide curtained entrance to enclosed areas. Curtain colours available are red, blue or grey. Please specify colour when ordering.
E	HAT & COAT RACK	Six hat and coat hooks on a rail which connects to two aluminium wall uprights (spans panel).
F	FLAT SHELF	White melamine shelf 1m wide (nominal) x 0.3m deep. Positioned so as to span panel widths. When ordering please indicate clearly exact positions and heights. Maximum load per meter of shelf – 10Kg – please discuss greater requirements with Stanco.
G	ANGLED SHELF	As above but with angle adjustment and lip on front edge. Maximum load per meter of shelf – 7Kg – please discuss greater requirements with Stanco.
H	DISPLAY PANEL	0.99m x 0.99m display panel covered blue, black, red, green or grey loop nylon.
J	CHAIN HANGING PACKS	Chain hanging packs enable exhibitors to fix their own display panels on chains from the top of walls (20Kg max. load). Each pack contains two 1m lengths of chain, two screw eyes and two Octanorm clips. (Collect on site). For larger items please contact Stanco with sizes and weights to enable Stanco to advise fixing instructions.
K	LITERATURE DISPENSER	1m long (nominal) white-coated literature dispenser with clear Perspex front divided into four A4 sized sections.
L	DISPLAY COUNTER	Display counter 0.95m wide x 0.50m deep x 1.00m high with black, white or beech top, front and sides, lockable doors and internal shelf (SD78).
M	ILLUMINATED GLASS DISPLAY	Illuminated glass display counter 1.22m wide x 0.60m deep x 0.91m high with sliding glass doors and one internal full depth shelf (SD75). Please order a 13amp socket outlet from the Official Electrical Contractor (Appendix 5)
N	MUSLIN CEILING	White flameproof muslin ceiling stretched over stand area above ceiling grid.
R	COLOUR CHANGE	Shell scheme wall panels and additional wall panels can have the face finished in a loop nylon material to an available colour to your choice. This will be Hook & Loop Fastener compatible.
T	HOOK & LOOP FASTENER (ROLLS)	1m long strips of Hook & Loop available on outright sale.
V	100mm RAISED PLATFORM	Raised platforms provide a convenient way to route electrics, plumbing or other cable runs to areas in the centre of the stand. The standard 100mm platform is available by the square meter and includes black painted skirting. (See section 5.2.6 regarding floorcovering)
	SLAT WALLS	2.43m x 0.99m Slat wall overlay panels finished in white or grey with a contrast horizontal colour inserts. Panels to be fixed to existing shell scheme walls
	PEGBOARD OVERLAYS	2.34m x 0.95m Pegboard overlay panels in a timber frame and all finished white. Panels to be fixed to existing shell scheme walls.

Stanco's quoted prices are based on the current costs of materials and labour. Stanco reserves the right to pass on any price increases which occur prior to the completion of any work.

2. DELIVERY

Orders and delivery dates are accepted subject to Stanco being able to secure the necessary labour and materials. Stanco accepts no responsibility for non or part completion due to any cause beyond Stanco's control.

3. PAYMENT

The Customer shall make full payment of the agreed contract price at the time of placing the order. This shall also apply to additions to or amendments of the order. Time shall be of the essence and Stanco will not process any orders unless and until this condition is satisfied.

4. FORCE MAJEURE

If, by reasons of force majeure, labour difficulties or shortage of materials, or any cause beyond Stanco's control, Stanco is unable to provide all or any of the goods and services ordered by the customer during the whole or part of the duration of the exhibition, Stanco's liability shall be limited to the return of a corresponding proportion of the charges paid and payable by the customer for such goods and services and Stanco shall not be liable for any loss or consequential costs.

5. FAILURE TO PAY

If any customer, for whatever reason, fails to pay any account once it has fallen due, Stanco reserves the right to recover Stanco's goods and to suspend delivery of further goods or the execution of further work to the customer or any associated company, without prejudice to Stanco's right to recover any loss sustained.

6. GOODS ON HIRE

All goods, materials, plant or machinery supplied by Stanco, shall be on hire unless otherwise stated. The period of hire will be the tenancy period of the exhibition unless otherwise stated. Stanco shall enter the exhibition premises to collect and to remove the items on hire as soon as permitted by the exhibition organisers after the close of the exhibition. All such goods etc. shall be entirely at the customer's risk from the time of delivery or installation at the exhibition premises (as appropriate) until collection by Stanco and the customer shall reimburse Stanco for any loss or damage to same whilst on hire.

7. LIABILITY

- a) Stanco does not exclude its liability in respect of death, or personal injury of any party resulting from negligence of ourselves, Stanco's servants, or agents (but not of Stanco's subcontractors, if any).
- b) Stanco does not exclude Stanco's liability for loss of, or damage to the exhibits or property of the customer where this has directly been caused by Stanco's negligence, provided that any claim in this respect is made in writing within 7 days of the incident and either a Stanco representative on site or the exhibition organiser have been informed of the loss whilst the show is open.
- c) Any claim resulting from (b) shall be limited to the amount of any loss of or diminution in value of the goods, and Stanco shall not be liable for any consequential costs or any loss of profits.

8. CUSTOMER'S INDEMNITY OF STANCO

Save as expressly provided in all these conditions, the customer shall indemnify Stanco against all actions, claims and demands whatsoever arising from any loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by any party as a result of Stanco's conduct in completing the contract or complying with any exhibition conditions.

9. ORGANISER'S RULES

The customer shall comply with all conditions imposed by the Organisers of the Exhibition and shall be solely responsible for obtaining written consent from these parties for any modifications or waiver of said conditions.

10. LIMITATION OF STANCO'S LIABILITY

Stanco is not responsible for any injury or damage to property or any loss or damage direct or indirect and of whatever nature caused or arising out of:

- a) delay or failure to deliver goods or materials or to carry out work from causes outside Stanco's control.
- b) failure or defect in any goods or materials, plant or fittings not manufactured by Stanco.

11. CHANGES AFTER ORDER TAKEN

Stanco reserves the right to pass on to a customer any additional costs in association with the contract due to alterations incurred at the behest of the customer, the exhibition promoter or the safety officers, after the date of the order.

12. STANCO PROPERTY

All quotations, designs, drawings, plans and models prepared by Stanco remain Stanco's property and Stanco's copyright.

13. ORDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, these Terms and Conditions apply to all contracts entered into by Stanco to the exclusion of any terms and conditions contained in the customer's order which conflict or purport to modify them, and to the exclusion of any conditions or warranties implied by common law or statute.

14. LATE ORDERS

Orders received or amended later than the return date shown on the order form or other documents will not be carried out until after completion of orders received prior to this date. Late orders will be subject to a 20% surcharge and will be carried out in the order in which they are received and will only be accepted on this basis.

15. COMPLAINTS

Complaints with regard to the services provided must be submitted in writing during the open period of the exhibition. This will ensure that they are fully investigated on site. No liability for claims can be accepted unless this condition is complied with.

16. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of orders must be submitted in writing. Where written cancellation is received later than one week prior to the start of the exhibition build-up, the services ordered will be charged at the full rate, as the work is prepared in advance.

17. LAW

The contract shall in all respects be governed by and construed and interpreted in accordance with laws of England and the customer agrees to submit itself to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
