

LORRY PARKING

Lorry parking facilities for empty vehicles of 3.5 tons and above are available in the North West Lorry Park (see Venue Map). Parking is free of charge during build-up and breakdown although spaces are limited. Parking on open days is charged at £30 per day per lorry plus VAT and is ONLY AVAILABLE ON THE DAY ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS.

Traffic Administration Office hours are 09.00 – 18.00 Monday to Friday. Arrivals outside these hours will be directed to Truck World in Thurrock

Parking on build-up days only will be permitted using the Lorry way Access Document, which must be clearly displayed on the vehicle window. Vehicles must be removed prior to the open days unless a valid Parking Permit has been issued.

Any vehicle failing to display a valid Parking Permit or displaying an out of date permit will be clamped and a fee of £150 will be charged for release.

All vehicles parked in the North West Lorry Park should be empty of all goods and stock. ExCeL and its partners accept no responsibility for loss, damage or theft to vehicles or their contents.

Overnight sleeping in vehicles is prohibited.

Drivers must at all times follow instructions issued by traffic marshals.

LOW EMISSION ZONE

The Low Emission Zone (LEZ) is an area covering most of Greater London within which the most polluting diesel-engine vehicles are required to meet specific emissions standards. This covers lorries over 3.5 tonnes and buses and coaches over 5 tonnes. Other vehicles will come within the scope of the regulations during 2010. Vehicles that do not comply will have to pay a daily charge. The emissions standards for the LEZ are based on Euro standards. These define the limits for exhaust emissions for new vehicles sold in the European Union (EU) member states with which vehicles must comply when manufactured. The LEZ is enforced using fixed and mobile cameras which read your vehicle's number plate (or Vehicle Registration Mark) as you travel within the zone and check this against a database of registered vehicles that:

- a) Meet with the LEZ emissions standards **or**
- b) Have paid the daily charge **or**
- c) Are either exempt or registered for a 100% discount
